Do you sincerely receive and adopt the Westminster Confession of Faith and the Catechisms of this Church, as containing the system of doctrine taught in the Holy Scriptures; and do you further promise that if at any time you find yourself out of accord with any of the fundamentals of this system of doctrine, you will, on your own initiative make known to your Session the change which has taken place in your views since the assumption of this ordination vow? Do you?

- 3. Do you approve of the form of government and discipline of the Presbyterian Church, in conformity with the general principles of Biblical polity? Do you?
- 4. Do you accept the office of Deacon in this church, and promise faithfully to perform all the duties thereof, and to endeavor by the grace of God to adorn the profession of the Gospel in your life, and to set a worthy example before the church of which God has made you an officer? Do you?
- 5. Do you promise subjection to your brethren in the Lord? Do you?
- 6. Do you promise to strive for the edification, peace, unity, and purity of the Church? Do you?
