1. Paul opens this letter not with theology but with thanksgiving for the faith of believers he had never met. Whose faith could you begin thanking God for this week?
2. Paul longs to be "mutually encouraged" by the faith of the Romans (v. 12). What would it look like for ministry in our church to be a genuine two-way street?
3. Paul "often intended" to come to Rome but was prevented—and that delay gave us this letter. Where in your life has God's "no" produced something better than your plan?
4. Paul describes himself as "eager" to preach the gospel. Where do you sit between Paul's eagerness and Jonah's reluctance? Name one person you can begin carrying in prayer this week.
