The Room We Cannot Leave Yet

Questions:

1. Three times in this chapter, "God gave them up." We tend to picture God's wrath as something loud and fiery, but here it looks like God simply letting people have what they asked for. Why is that kind of judgment more frightening, not less? Where might we be quietly praying for something we'd be better off not receiving?
2. Paul's list in vv. 29–31 sets the "respectable" sins—gossip, boasting, disobedience to parents—right next to murder and hating God, and refuses to let us rank ourselves. Which sins are we most tempted to excuse because they feel small or socially acceptable? What changes when we read the list as a mirror rather than a description of someone else?
3. Verse 32 names the lowest point: not just doing what is wrong, but "giving approval to those who practice" it. Where do you see our culture—or your own heart—moving from committing sin to celebrating it? Why is applause a deeper problem than the act itself?

4. The cure for disordered desire isn't the death of desire but its homecoming: the same longing that once enslaved us is the longing the angels feel as they "long to look" into the gospel (1 Pet. 1:12). What are your desires most set on right now? What would it look like this week for Christ to become not merely a duty, but your deepest desire?
