Questions:

1. Paul lists Israel's real privileges (vv. 17–20). What privileges do we enjoy as a church — and how can good gifts quietly become false confidence before God?
2. Paul's questions in vv. 21–23 expose the gap between teaching and doing. Where do you most feel the gap between what you profess and what you practice?
3. "The name of God is blasphemed... because of you" (v. 24). How does our conduct shape how outsiders — and our own children — see Christ and his church?
4. Jesus, the true Israelite, fully possessed everything he professed. How does his obedience in our place both humble us and free us to confess hypocrisy rather than hide it?
