3. Verses 14-15 say even those without God's written law have his law "written on their hearts." Where have you seen your own conscience accuse or excuse you lately?
4. The sermon's mirror illustration shows us reading our own charges. What would it look like this week to stop defending yourself and instead run to Christ, who already served your sentence?
