Every Mouth Stopped

Romans 3:9–20 (Pew pg. 940/LP pg. 1174)

- I. The Charge: All Under Sin (v. 9)
- II. The Evidence: Depravity in Every Faculty (v. 10–18)
- III. The Verdict: A Silenced World, A Powerless Law (v. 19–20)

Questions:

1. Paul says all people — Jew and Gentile alike — are "under sin" (v. 9), not just guilty of scattered sins but under sin's authority. How does thinking of sin as a ruling power rather than a list of bad deeds change the way you examine your own life this week?
2. The catena in verses 10–18 touches the mind, mouth, feet, and eyes — heart, speech, conduct, and worship. Which of these areas is easiest for you to excuse or overlook in yourself, and why?
3. Verse 19 says the law's purpose is that "every mouth may be stopped." What excuses, comparisons, or self-defenses do you find yourself reaching for when convicted of sin — and what would it look like to let God actually silence them instead?
4. Verse 20 ends with diagnosis, not a cure. Why is it good news, not bad news, that the law can only show us our sickness and not heal it? How does this set up our need for the "But now" of verse 21?
